The Alameda All Stars



Founded in 1979, **The Alameda All Stars** began its humble roots as a local club band that soon became a hometown and Bay Area favorite. With a mix of hard-driving rock 'n roll, blues, R & B, and funk, **The Alameda All Stars** never lacked for energy or an appreciative audience.

By 1990, The Alameda All Stars drew the attention of southern rock icon Gregg Allman. Touring with his solo band, Gregg Allman & Friends, they performed throughout the US, Canada and Japan for 14 years. In 1994, Gregg Allman & Friends performed at San Francisco's Bay to Breakers run in Golden Gate Park to a crowd of 200,000+. The band also recorded on two of Gregg's solo albums, Searching for Simplicity (1997 Sony, produced by Tom Dowd), and No Stranger to the Dark: The Best of Gregg Allman (2002 Sony).

In 2007, **The Alameda All Stars** backed up ultra-keyboardist **Brian Auger** at the **40th Anniversary of the Summer of Love** at the fabled Speedway Meadows in San Francisco's Golden Gate Park. Two years later in 2009, The **Alameda All Stars** returned to Speedway Meadows to perform at **West Fest**, celebrating the **40th Anniversary of Woodstock**, backing up **Lesley West (Mountain)**, and **Denny Laine (The Moody Blues** and **Paul McCartney's** touring band). Both events estimated crowds at 100,000+.

Over the years, **The Alameda All Stars** have performed both as a standalone band, and as backup for numerous diverse artists, such as Warren Haynes and Allen Woody (The Allman Brothers Band), Joe Satriani, Harvey Mandel (The Rolling Stones), David & Linda LaFlamme (It's a Beautiful Day), Norman Greenbaum, Dickie Petersen (Blue Cheer), Greg Douglas (Steve Miller Band), Maria Muldaur, Jimmy Hall (Wet Willie Band), Roy Rogers, Lester Chambers (The Chambers Brothers), Greg Kihn, as well as for **Alameda All Stars** Alumni members Brad Gillis (Ozzy Osbourne, Night Ranger) and Dan Chauncey (38 Special).

Throughout their 43-year history, **The Alameda All Stars** have always maintained a high level of musicianship and professional approach to entertaining audiences with a well-planned stage show. The band looks forward to many more years of music, fun, and friendship with each other, our alumni band members, and our fans.
